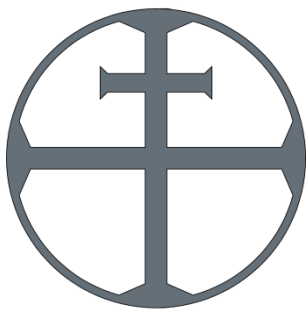

Fr James Pashturro

We welcome Fr James Pashturro as our Preacher at the Sung Eucharist at Holy Trinity today. *Fr Jim is currently priest-in-charge of two congregations within the Diocese of Michigan. He serves at the suburban St John's in Howell, and the village church of St Stephen's in Hamburg. In addition, he also serves on the diocesan Commission on Ministry that is responsible to guiding those discerning a call to ordination. A graduate of Bexley Seabury Seminary in Columbus, Ohio he was ordained to the priesthood in June of 2016 shortly after graduation and began serving both his congregations thereafter. Prior to this, he received his bachelor and master of arts degrees in psychology before working in corporate information technology management for fifteen years. Married to Gabriela for nineteen years, together they are parents to Rachael, Jules and Luciana.
