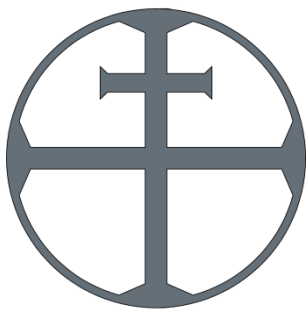

Pilgrimage to Walsingham 2018

Last year, 23 members of our parish took part in our second Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham in Norfolk. We will be travelling again to England's Nazareth this year from Friday 24 August to Monday 27 August. Annual Parochial Church Update

We held the Annual Parochial Church Meeting on a Sunday for the first time last week and were delighted that 60 members of the congregation took part. This was the best attendance over the past 3 years.

The following people were elected: Jeffrey Kabel and Caroline Watts were both unanimously elected to serve as Churchwardens for another year.

Six members of the congregation on the electoral roll and eligible for membership had indicated their willingness to stand for election on to the Parochial Church Council.: Bendu Cooper, Adam Frost, Charles Pitt and Andrew Reeves were elected to serve for three years. Michael Ashcroft for two years and John Dupont for one year. Lawrence Deneault was co-opted.

The election of Richard Schafer and Emma Dupont as members of the Deanery Synod was unanimously approved.
