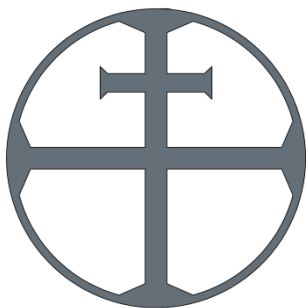

Walk the Night on Saturday 14 July

Walk the Night is the first ever event to bring men and women together in exclusive support of the charities, Breast Cancer Care and Prostate Cancer UK. The challenge is on to walk a marathon (26.2 miles) or a half marathon (13.1 miles) throughout the night on a circular route, starting and finishing at Granary Square near the iconic King's Cross station. The route will take the challengers past many famous landmarks, including Westminster Abbey, Trafalgar Square, Buckingham Palace and Holy Trinity Church, Sloane Square!

This challenge has attracted over a thousand men and women, all coming together to raise funds and awareness of these two invaluable charities and to show their strong support of men and women across the UK affected by cancer.
