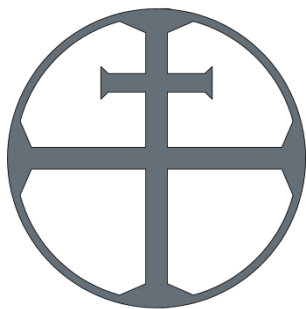

Lent 2018

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, 14 February, and provides each of us with a fresh opportunity to deepen our Christian discipleship.

- **Ways into Prayer**

There are so many ways to pray. On Tuesday evenings throughout Lent after the 6.30pm Mass, Fr. Paul will lead a workshop on different ways of prayer and answer your questions, starting on February 20.

- **Hunger Lunch and Lent Talks**

On Wednesday lunchtimes, Fr. Grant will lead us in a short course in which six well-known personalities invite us to discover anew the meaning of Jesus' ministry and Passion through talks broadcast on the BBC. Each Wednesday we will begin at 12 noon with a simple lunch of soup and bread and conclude in time for the 1pm Holy Communion service for those who wish to stay for it. We begin on Wednesday 21 February.

- **Lent Study Group**

Our Lent Study Group, which meets on Wednesday nights at 7pm from February 21 at 70 BookHaus, Cadogan Place, is based on the BBC TV series, 'Broken'. The series focuses on the life and ministry Father Michael Kerrigan, a Roman Catholic, priest who, despite past trauma and anxiety about his own inadequacies, attempts to bring the light of Christ into the lives of the people amongst whom he ministers. The series portrays real life at its most gritty and unvarnished, and in doing so raises many questions along the way about how to live faithfully when life is very hard.

- **Stations of the Cross**

We walk with Jesus Christ the last steps of his journey to the Cross every Thursday from 22 February at 6.30pm.
