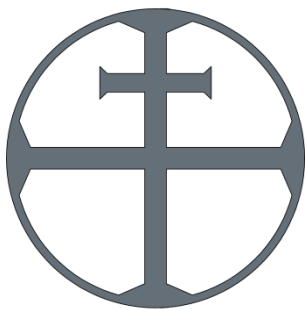

Older People's Project

Thanks to a generous legacy from a former member of our congregation, we will be launching an Older People's Project in our parish in the course of 2018. The aim is to improve the quality of life of older people in our congregation and those living in our parish.

The first step on this journey takes place on Sunday 4 February when we welcome Ann Morisy, the Development officer of PSALM (Project for Seniors and Lifelong Ministry) to preach at the 11am Sung Eucharist.

Afterwards there will be lunch at the Sloane Club at which Ann will open up some of the opportunities before us. We are able to offer tickets for this lunch at £10 per

person (excluding drinks) for the first 50 people who are either aged 65 or over or keen to be involved in the project in some way. There are 20 tickets at the full price of £20 for those of any age who simply want to enjoy a nice lunch.
