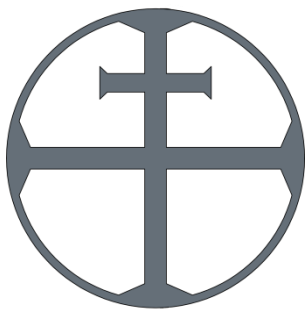

## **New Eucharistic Ministers Open House Weekend: September 16 and 17**

Once again, this year, Holy Trinity is part of London's very popular Open House weekend. So join us for a weekend of guided tours, the opening of our archives, music and special services, celebrating our church and its Arts and Crafts legacy.

## **Parish Room redecoration**

The Parochial Church Council met on Wednesday and approved an imaginative proposal for the redecoration of the Parish Room. The work will be carried out in two stages: Stage 1 involves the re-sanding and sealing of the parquet floor, repainting of the walls, installation of spotlights and a William Morris hanging. Stage 2 will see the commissioning of a new rug and the repainting of the lantern with an inspiring new design. The PCC are grateful to Roy Hyslop for his help with the project. The work will be paid for by a grant from the Monument Trust in memory of Ron Gurney, sometime Secretary of the Friends of Holy Trinity Church. A display of the proposals will appear in church shortly.

The speaker at our next Sunday Conversation on 24 September is Lord Green of Hurstpierpoint who will be talking to us about his latest book on European identity.
